

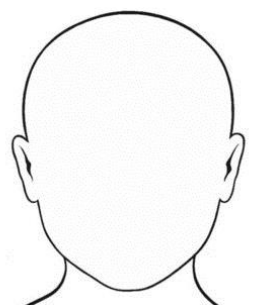
Welcome to the Winter EuroBillTracker Meeting 2014 in Lisbon, Portugal.

Your guides will be willing to help in any way they can.

Our phone numbers should only be used in emergencies (if you get hit by a car, if there's a tsunami, if nasty aliens land on Portugal, or if you forget to register a 500-euro bill)



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- **Times** are shown on the schedule (on the following pages) so that **you can join us whenever you want**. We'll keep our plan as timely as possible but **you're free to stay or stray in any given place and rejoin us later**.

If you booked any preset meal, though, we're counting on you and will have to charge you the fee even if you miss it.

- **Addresses** and **coords** are shown so that you can get to the places using your favorite navigation system (or show to taxi drivers if you need).
- **Postal codes** are shown so that you know **where to register notes**.
- **Money**. Yes, we're only in it for the money. Please **pay everything in 5-euro banknotes** in order to avoid unnecessary and uninteresting hits. This is in fact an EBT rule; all easily traceable as meeting hits will be moderated and won't count for your hit statistics.
- In Lisbon, you can **withdraw 5-euro banknotes at some ATMs**. Some of them are very near the restaurants and other venues on the program. If you have a smartphone, you can look on our special map for the nearest ATM carrying 5-euro banknotes: <http://goo.gl/wgkFBX>. If you click on any of the markers, you'll see all the relevant information, including address, latitude + longitude, and postal code.
- **Challenges** are your chance of winning a **prize**. The score is simple: **2 points** for each correct answer, and **1 negative point for each wrong answer**. Zero points for no answer. There's only one correct answer per challenge.
- The three EBTists who score the most will win a bunch of short codes + serial numbers of unregistered 5-euro notes recently withdrawn in Lisbon. The organizers will carry the notes with them and you'll be able to see them (except for the short codes + serial numbers, of course). There are **290 notes to register!** (Lisbon has a hit ratio of 1 : 289 for fivers.) If you win, you're not winning any money, just what we cherish the most: its traceable data. The organizers had to restrain themselves from registering these notes, and it was hard. ☺

Grand prize: **170** notes. 2nd prize: **80** notes. 3rd prize: **40** notes.

- In order to run for the prizes, you must **return these pages to the organization** at the last place we are to see you, wait for us to take a picture of your answers and give you these sheets back. This, along with **signing ALL pages with your EBT name**, is **your responsibility**, will take only a few seconds and then you have to trust us. No one of the four guides will be able to enter the competition. The winner will be known after the entire meeting is done and everybody went home. Even if you don't stay until the end, you still have a chance of winning, but the more answers you give the best are your chances. We'll send the winner a file containing all the needed data: the short codes + serial numbers, together with the postal code of the last place where they gave an answer to the challenge quiz. After everything is done and the winner is determined, the notes will be spread all over by the organizers.
